General Function

To follow the direction of the Program Coordinator. To supervise groups of school age children and ensure all children's individual needs are met with dignity and respect as well as their safety by following YMCA policies and procedures. Entry Requirements

- Must have or be able to obtain a Commercial License
- Must complete the YMCA Transportation Policy packet
- Must have a clean Oregon DMV driving record
- Must pass a behind the wheel drive test
- Must be on the Oregon Childcare Registry
- Will need to be CPR and 1st Aid certified

Job Requirements

- Must understand and adhere to Child Abuse Prevention and YMCA Policy and Procedure Manual at all times.
- Must report any suspicion of child abuse or neglect as per YMCA guidelines.
- Must be patient and able to make sound judgments in a timely manner on a daily basis while interacting with children.
- Must be able and willing to work with all children regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability.
- Required to supervise children while in transit and know where all children are at all times.
- Must attend required staff meetings.
- Must adhere to the Dress Code.
- Must be reliable, prompt and practice excellent attendance.

Physical/Mental Requirements

- Must be physically capable of observing and listening for children at all times.
- Must be physically capable of lifting 40 pounds.
- Must be able to quickly reach a child and/or situation to prevent harm.
