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Program Information:

Play and Learn and The Extension General Information:

- Play and Learn and The Extension are drop off centers available for Y families with a family membership.
- As these are non-licensed drop-in programs, usage may not exceed 2 hours.
- Parents are required to stay in the building while their children are checked into these programs.
- Parents are requested to show their membership cards and completely fill out the information on the sign in sheet.
- Parents are required to check in and check out their children.
- Once a child is checked into Play and Learn or The Extension they are not allowed to leave until checked out by the person authorized to pick them up.
- Experienced staff members are employed in addition to volunteers for assistance. All adults working or volunteering have passed an interview process, orientation, and a thorough background check. All staff members are First Aid/CPR Certified and have their Food Handlers.
- For the safety of the children we check in we maintain a set adult to child ratio. Once the maximum ratio is reached we close to additional children until another staff person can come help. A staff member can let you know what the approximate wait time will be.
- We ask that you do not check in your children if they have been ill with a fever, vomiting, diarrhea or an excessively green runny nose.
- In case of an emergency evacuation Play and Learn and The Extension staff and children will leave the building via the Cottage Street exit. They will wait in the Ike Box Parking Area until safely allowed to return to the building.
- Play and Learn and The Extension will close 15 minutes early if no children are present.

Play and Learn Specifics:

- Parents are to supply diapers and wipes necessary for their child's use.
- It is recommended to leave a change of clothes for children who are toilet training or of preschool age in case of a bathroom accident. For safety reasons Play and Learn staff and volunteers are NOT allowed to assist in toilet training. This including pulling down their pants, setting them on the toilet or wiping them.
- For infants, please provide already prepared bottles if they will need one during their stay. We have a bottle warmer to keep the bottle warm during their stay.
- Healthy snacks and/or beverages are encouraged. For the consideration of children who have an allergic reaction to peanuts and/or tree nuts, Play and Learn does have a strict policy against any snacks that include peanuts or any other tree nuts. Any product containing the phrase, "May contain trace amounts of nuts" or a similar phrase is not allowed.
- We do contact parents and request that they pick up their children for the following reasons: the child is upset/crying and we are unable to distract or console them; injury or illness; bathroom accident; and for children with behavior affecting the safety of other children. (i.e hitting, kicking, biting, etc....)

The Extension Specifics:

- The Extension includes a foosball table, board games, puzzles, books, coloring and arts and crafts activities.
- Children are welcome to bring their own healthy snacks and beverages but are expected to tidy up after themselves.
